#### Notes to the Interim Financial Statements for the period ended 30 September 2019

- The Accounting policies and methods of computation followed in the Interim Financial Statements are the same as that of the latest year end Financial Statements.
- 2. The Stated Capital consists of 53,725,463 Ordinary shares.
- 3. Events Occurring After the Reporting Date

There have been no material events occurring after the reporting date that require adjustment or disclosure in the financial statements.

#### 4. Contingent Liability

An income Tax assessment for Rs. 33 million was issued on the Company for year of assessment 2016/17. The Company has already lodged a formal appeal to the Tax Appeal Commission, setting out our submissions and requesting for withdrawal of the assessment. The Company believes it has a strong case.

There have been no other material changes to the contingent liabilities since the last annual reporting period, other than those disclosed above.

#### 5: Net Financial Expenses

Net Financial Expenses increased mainly due to the borrowings for significant Capital Expenditure and cessation of capitalization of borrowing costs on completion of a key project.

#### 6. Income Taxes

With the application of New Inland Revenue Act w.e.f. 01 April 2018, the Company's profit is liable to tax at 28%. Whereas, prior to 01 April 2018, qualifying export profits were taxed at a concessionary rate of 12%, profits from the Ready-To-Drink milk business were taxed at a concessionary rate of 10% and profits with respect to off-shore business earned in foreign currency were exempt from income tax. This has resulted in a significant increase in the overall tax cost of the company.
