

## Speaker of Sri Lankan Parliament Honours Nestlé for Strong Contribution to the Economic and Social Development of the Country

By taking a long-term view of business development and managing it responsibly, we are able to stimulate significant local social, environmental and economic development. Nestlé Lanka is the largest exporter of coconut milk powder in the world and Sri Lanka's largest collector of fresh milk in the private sector. The company purchases over 50 million Sri Lankan coconuts a year and procures milk from over 15,000 local farmers every day across the island. The company has enhanced its local procurement to include rice, vegetables, fruits, salt and spices for its popular products like NESTUM, CERELAC and MAGGI Ricey Noodles which are enriched with traditional, nutritious ingredients and come to consumers in indigenous flavours.
